



NORTHERN AREA PERFORMANCE THEATRE AWARDS SCHOLARSHIPS

History

The Napta Charitable Trust was established to recognise excellence and talent in musical theatre in the Northern region of the Musical Theatre New Zealand, covering an area from Pukekohe to Kerikeri. The Trust's role is to advance the education of performers in the performing arts and in particular to assist and encourage performers to acquire and develop further skills and expertise in performance, either here in New Zealand or overseas.

Mission of the Trust

To offer financial assistance for a recognised course of study or programme in the areas of education – performing arts, music, dance and drama.

Scholarships will not be awarded for the following:

- Travel and accommodation costs
- Purchase of capital items
- Incomplete or late applications

Eligibility

Applicants must be from individuals only and be aged from 18 years upwards (as at the closing date of applications) and a New Zealand citizen or having permanent resident status.

Applicants must reside within the Northern region (Zone I – Pukekohe to Kerikeri) of the Musical Theatre New Zealand.

Applicants must be affiliated with one or more Zone 1 NAPTA participating societies.

Award Value and Tenure

Two NZ\$1,000 scholarships to be offered per year.

Information Required

Scholarship application forms are available from the NAPTA website and your application must reach the postal address by the closing date. Late applications will not be considered except in the most compelling circumstances and in the unfettered discretion of NAPTA.



Decision Process

The successful applicants will be selected by the current Trustees of the NAPTA Trust.

The decisions of the current Trustees of the NAPTA Trust shall be **final** and no communications or discussions will be entered into.

Applicants to Note

Include your resume and a stamped addressed envelope if you wish the resume to be returned.

Send copies only of your important personal documents.

Retain a copy of your application for your reference.

Scholarships will be presented at the NAPTA Awards and Scholarships Evening in February of each year.

Scholarships will be payable on receipt of invoice from course of study or programme.
